Players are to register in the Lynher Building at Truro College from 09:45am. Upon arrival the outside changing rooms will be open to store kit and change, please then proceed to register in the foyer of the Lynher building (astro pitch end) with myself.

Players will need to bring suitable training clothing for an astro pitch and grass fields. You will need a gum shield, boots and trainers, please ensure they head out to the coaching session with everything they need as we don't want to lose time returning to the changing rooms to collect further kit during the sessions.

Players do not need to bring a packed lunch, because they will eat after or prior to their session. They can and should bring plenty to drink for the session and some snacks for refuelling post session though.

Unfortunately, due to the large numbers we cannot respond to everyone to confirm receipt of your application, so all those who apply will be accepted. Please be mindful that we need to ensure the ratio of coaches to players is correct, so **please return your forms and payment before Friday 3rd February.**
